Chief Master Sergeant Stephen J. Bush



Chief Master Sergeant Stephen J. Bush is Chief Enlisted Manger assigned to the 7th Services Squadron, Dyess Air Force Base, Texas. He provides direct oversight and guidance to the operational readiness and effectiveness of Services Combat Support facilities, people and assets totaling \$35M, ensuring the effective use of programs and manpower to support the morale and quality of life of 13,000 active duty military, dependents, DoD civilians and retirees. Chief Master Sergeant Bush oversees the technical and professional development of 82 enlisted personnel.

Chief Master Sergeant Bush was born in Philadelphia PA. He graduated from Father Judge High School, Philadelphia PA in 1981 and enlisted in the Air Force on 7 December 1981. He graduated technical school at Lackland Air Force Base, San Antonio Texas in April 1982 as a Law Enforcement Specialist. He began his career at Edwards Air Force Base as a Law Enforcement Specialist. In January 1986, Chief Bush retrained as a Commissary Management Specialist at Fairchild AFB, Washington State. As a Commissary Management Specialist, he held positions as Produce Manager, Receiving Supervisor, Merchandiser, Grocery Manager, Store Manager and

Troop Support Manager. In 1995 Chief Bush started his Services career while assigned to HQ USAFE Services Directorate, Ramstein AB, Germany as Command Subsistence Superintendent, responsible for the implementation of \$79M Prime Vendor food contract for all USAFE Air Force Food Service Operations. Upon return to CONUS In 1999, he was assigned to the 7th Services Squadron, Dyess AFB, Texas. He served in positions as Fitness Center Director, Squadron Superintendent, Combat Support Flight Chief, Community Support Flight Chief and Food Service Superintendent. In 2001, he volunteered for a remote assignment to Kunsan Air Base, Republic of Korea as Services Superintendent and Business Operations Flight Chief. He then was reassigned back to Dyess Air Force Base, Texas in 2002 as Food Service Superintendent and in June 2005 he assumed his new duties as Chief Enlisted Manger for 7th Services Squadron.

Chief Master Sergeant Bush is married to the former Denise D. Michaud of Camp Jeune North Carolina. They have four children; Adam 24, Stephanie 23, Leslie 21 and Brandon 12.
